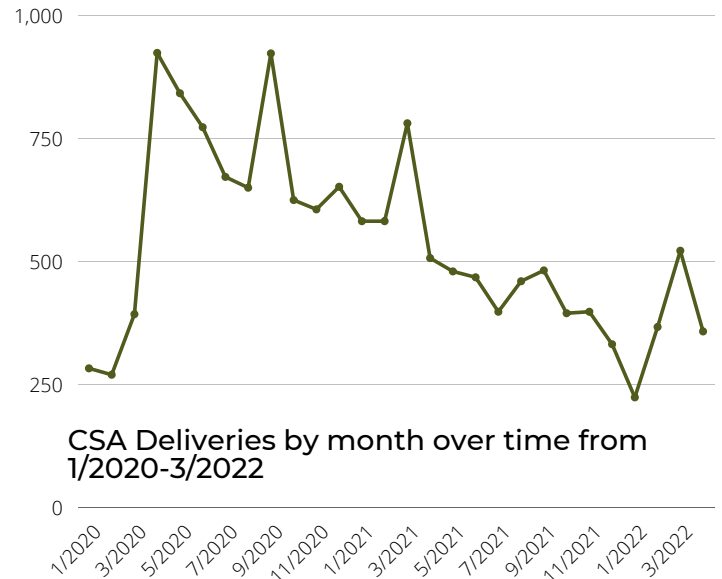


FINANCIAL REPORT

CSA Deliveries By Month

This summarized update comes during a time of deep need. We hope that the community can support us in this time of need.



CSA Deliveries by month over time from 1/2020-3/2022

Our CSA program grew very rapidly during the height of the COVID-19 lockdowns once people began to realize the vulnerability of the global food system and supply chain. Since the lockdowns have been lifted, our CSA numbers have dropped significantly as people returned to grocery stores and caused a problem in creating sufficient revenue from our CSA program

Our Solidarity Shares program began in 2020 with supplying a box of 7-9 items of produce and two pounds of both beans and rice to 6 farmworker families free of cost. Our last grant from the Rebozo Festival will allow us to feed a total of 40 farmworker families beginning June 2022.

Starting in June of 2022, we will be increasing the cost of the Solidarity Shares boxes to \$40 per box to better reflect the internal costs of running this program.
